

Speech Evaluation Form

Rate each speech, (1 = weak; 6 = strong), and justify your rating with constructive suggestions for improvement. Consider: Originality of Thought (advances debate rather than repeats previously stated ideas; refutes opposing arguments); Organization and Unity (cohesively links ideas); Evidence and Logic (cites credible sources, connecting to claims); Delivery (extemporaneous speaking vs. reciting a manuscript, seriousness of purpose, style and poise). How well the speaker answers questions also should be considered.

You will rank students, holistically, at the end of the session, on a separate form.
